

▲ Velocity Zip Line Kit A few hours' worth of elbow grease and you'll be zip lining across your backyard like a Bud-fueled Batman. This kit has the basics — a trolley with sealed bearings for speeds up to 40 mph, a carabiner, and a 20-inch knurled steel handle. ### SUMMER SKILLS

PICK THE RIGHT SPOT FOR A ZIP LINE



Look for two trees with no obstacles between, unless you're zip lining for comedic effect. They should be at least 15 inches in diameter, otherwise your zip line could sway like a Pentecostal choir. Fifty feet of distance is the minimum longer is better - and you'll need the last 10 feet as a landing pad. (Hint: rubberized mulch.) You can tuck-and-roll, right?

### ▼ SuperGreen Skateboard

E-mail Hunter Smith with the exact size and specs of your dream downhill board, cruiser, or longboard, and two weeks later you'll hold a rolling piece of art hewn from bamboo. It turns out that the eco-friendly panda food is more durable and provides better feel than the average deck, so you'll ride better, too. [from \$399; supergreenboards.com]

### ▲ Pentax Optio W90

Whether you're at the beach or at Bonnaroo, you'll want a camera that can handle getting knocked around. The 12.1-megapixel W90 delivers all the point-and-shoot essentials — 5x optical zoom, 720p high-def video – plus, its burly rubberized case makes it sandproof, shock-resistant, and waterproof to 20 feet. ### A Ronix Ibex Wakeboard

Surfers may pity the coast-free folks of the flyover states, but that's because they've never sliced across a lake on a wakeboard. The Ibex is the Ferrari of decks, co-designed by the sport's figurehead, Parks Bonifav. His involvement led to an inch-wider tip and tail, plus a sharper rail, for faster cuts across the water. ### ▼ Zero DS Electric Motorcycle

Remember how envious you were when your neighbor's dad bought him a minibike? The electric Zero is the big-boy version. A four-hour charge delivers up to 60 miles of juice. With a top speed of 67 mph and on- or off-road capability, it's perfect as a summer runabout — and for making the neighbors jealous. [\$10,000; zeromotorcycles.com]

### ▶ FB Collection Lopes Mendes **Beach Bat Set**

Frescobol is a Brazilian sport resembling tennis, only it's played without a net and on a beach. Modern pros use fiberglass paddles, but these hand-varnished versions made from five pieces of Brazilian wood such as ipé and cedro — resemble the originals from the late '40s. [\$170; fbcollection.com]



### ▼ Projet MQ-9 Reaper 98-inch **RC UAV Predator Drone**

The allure of piloting a radiocontrolled Predator with an eight-foot wingspan is obvious, and further heightened if you opt for the voyeuristic chin-mounted videocam (\$50). One piece of advice: Don't fly the Projet drone anywhere near a military base. [\$140; nitroplanes.com]



### ▲ St. Pierre Tournament **Bocce Ball Set**


Nothing against horseshoes, but bocce may be the perfect backyard game: no pits to dig or stakes to set, and it always leaves one hand open for a brew. These perfectly shaped 107mm thermoplastic orbs meet the official specs of the U.S. Bocce Federation which means you won't have any excuses for botching a toss. [\$130; stpierreusa.com]



### SUMMER SKILLS BASH A BOCCE BALL

Rookies mistakenly line up the center of their body with their target - instead, line up your throwing arm with your opponent's ball. Begin your approach five paces back from the line. Two steps out, start your underhand toss. Keep your elbow tucked in and locked, and follow through by stepping past where you throw. Leave your hand aloft à la Reggie Miller if you know you've hit pay dirt.
